#### **Works Procurement Notice for a Component of the Programme**

(Tender No: AID 7279/Contracting/UGP 08/2)

1. The Works Procurement Notice refers to a component of the above-mentioned Programme - Procurement and installation of required technology and construction works for 2 wastewater treatment plants and appropriate collector pipelines in the municipality of Mavrovo-Rostuse.

2. The Scope of Works and Terms of Reference are defined in the Tender Documents.

3. The Bidder must be a National or International Construction Company with at least a 5-year relevant experience in construction of water and sanitation facilities and an annual turnover of at least 2.500.000 EURO over the last five years.

4. Interested parties can collect the Tender Documents at the Bureau for Economically Undeveloped Areas, Zeleznicka Str. bb, 1000, Skopje, Macedonia, between 09:00 and 15:00 hrs local time, every working day starting from the date of the last announcement (announcements will be published both in Italy and in Macedonia). The closing date for collection of the Tender Documents is 15 working days from the date of the last announcement.

5. Tender documents will be handed over to Bidders who have confirmed in writing (i.e. by e-mail or facsimile) their interest to participate at the Employer’s address/facsimile number indicated below.

6. Each Bidder is allowed to submit only one Proposal and only in the English language, which is the working language of the above-mentioned Programme. Only complete Proposals will be accepted.

7. Interested parties have to submit general and technical liability documents in accordance with articles 40 and 41 of the Macedonian Public Procurement Law (Official Gazette 19/2004).

8. Verification of the general liability of the Bidder will be evaluated through the following documents:

- Confirmation of solvency issued by Central Registry;
- Confirmation of paid taxes, contributions and other public fees, issued by the Public Revenue Office;
- Possession of document of Court registration of activities;
- Confirmation issued by a competent Court that bankruptcy or liquidation procedure has not been initiated;
- Confirmation of non-existence of an effective Court decision for interdiction of its business activities, as preventive measure.

All above-mentioned documents must not be older than six months and have to be submitted in an original or certified copy.

Foreign Bidders must submit an audit report (or any relevant documents issued by the National Institutions, as a confirmation of their general liability), which must be positive and issued by a recognized international auditing company.

9. Technical liability documents consist of:

- Reference list of similar performed tasks within the last five years, including contract amounts and titles, phone numbers and addresses of Clients;
- Available equipment and other physical capacities necessary for realization of the task;

- Managerial capabilities;
- Experience and professional personnel to perform procurement, which shall be proved with Curriculum Vitae of proposed team members, specifying the positions in the specific tasks.

10. The criteria for evaluation of the capability are:

Construction approach and Work programme/schedule	15%
Staff and organisation plan for each site	10%
Period for performance	10%
Way of payment (schedule, if any advanced payment)	10%
Price	45%
Available equipment	10%

11. All Bids must be submitted to the Bureau for Economically Undeveloped Areas, Zeleznicka Str. bb, 1000, Skopje, Macedonia, **within 52 days from the date of the last announcement, 12:00 hrs local time**. Late submissions will not be taken into consideration.

12. The price of the tender documents is 200 Euro. Payments by local Bidders can be made in MKD according to the exchange rate of the National Bank of Macedonia at the date of payment. This amount must be transferred to the Bureau for Economically Undeveloped Areas - Account No. 28001-00523785-28.
