



Germany faced technical difficulties to implement the keyword search as the information transmitted to OECD/DAC does often lack the project description. Therefore, a keyword search in the project decriptions does not reflect the amount of our disbursements for food and nutrition security (result was only 66.25 Mio. USD). We will solve this problem for the next reporting period by including more project descriptions. For reporting on 2015 we used an internal marker which indicates for each programme if FNS is a main or secondary objective (for programms where FNS is only a secondary objective only half of the amount is counted). Commitments accordingly 801.318.500 USD. Amounts cover only BMZ disbursements and commitments
