Other expenses (costs of processing visas, or eventual vaccination procedures for traveling to Brazil) will not be covered by InnSciD SP.

There are 40 vacancies for international participants and 40 vacancies for participants from Brazil. The main target audience for the school are students enrolled in Master's, doctoral or postdoctoral programs and who have interest in the school's topics. When presented with multiple candidates of similar abilities, we will aim to diversify/balance the group of students on the basis of gender and geographic origin.
