Imagery Intelligence Service Manager

(Information Fusion Centre/ Situational Awareness and Monitoring Division)

Tasks and responsibilities:

Reporting to the Head of Information Fusion Centre, the Imagery Intelligence Service Manager's responsibilities are as follows:

- To manage service implementation and delivery cycle for regular geospatial / imagery analysis services as well as for evolution services;
- To coordinate, evaluate and develop imagery analysis training for integrated border management in close cooperation with the services and training provider;
- To deliver tailored high-quality analysis on the nature and scope of illegal migration and associated cross border criminal activities;
- To provide support to analytical activities related to one of the areas of expertise listed below;
- > To support the development of methodologies for risk analysis and vulnerability assessment, within the area of expertise;
- To provide support in preparing risk assessments, reports, letters, briefing notes and responses to enquiries;
- To support the organisation of meetings, workshops, seminars and network cooperation relevant for the area of expertise, in the field of unit/sector activities;
- To support and implement working cooperation with other Frontex units/sectors promoting the best practices and knowledge-sharing;
- > To support and implement working cooperation with other EU institution and commercial service providers;
- > To support the implementation of the Copernicus Border Surveillance Service.

Selection criteria:
